

The Moral of the Story


The moral of the story is that good always triumphs over evil. No matter how hard the bad guys try, they can never defeat the good guys.

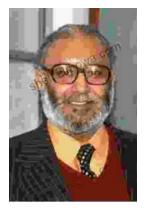
