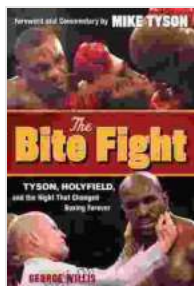


Tyson vs. Holyfield: The Night That Changed Boxing Forever

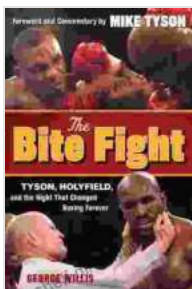
The bite shocked the boxing world and the general public alike. Tyson was immediately disqualified, and he was fined \$3 million. He was also suspended from boxing for two years.
